# CELI Certification

Co.As.It. Sydney is now an authorised CELI (Italian Language Recognised Certification) exam centre where you can register to sit for official exams. CELI is an exam that assesses an individual's level of fluency in Italian based on the standards established by the Council of Europe for the learning of modern languages. It is awarded by the Università 'per Stranieri' Perugia and is accepted as an official qualification by the Italian Ministry of Education and Research and the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. It is one of a few qualifications used by foreigners to gain entry into Italian universities. In 2010, Co.As.It. will be holding CELI exam sessions for adult students in June and November.

## Which course is right for you?
