Our adult classes run throughout the year, starting in February. Term 1 online classes last 9 weeks and classes are held once a week. Each lesson lasts 2 hours. In addition to the main class, there are three 1 hour free online conversation classes and one free online cultural event.

Classes will go ahead when a minimum of 5 students per class is reached. There is a maximum of 8 students per class.
