

Co.As.It. Italian Out of School Hours (OSH) Program Syllabus



The Italian OSH Syllabus is organised into four school terms, each lasting nine weeks, and is structured around common thematic areas that are shared by all students across K–6.

All learners engage with the same topics, ensuring continuity and coherence across classes, while differentiation is achieved through teaching strategies,

task complexity and expected outcomes, rather than through separate content pathways.

Students are provided with learning materials by their teacher, including a textbook, as well as specialised booklets developed by the Co.As.It Education Team in collaboration with Co.As.It teachers to support and extend classroom learning.
